

UNITED KINGDOM & IRELAND



To tour the United Kingdom and Ireland is to explore its long and enthralling heritage. Steeped in history; castles, historic towns, stately homes and remarkable cathedrals punctuate the beautiful and often dramatic countryside from the tranquil rolling hills of southern England to the shimmering fens of Norfolk and majestic mountain scenery of the Scottish Highlands. Furthermore, the UK & Ireland bristle with contemporary style; the cosmopolitan capitals of London, Dublin and Edinburgh seamlessly blending tradition with modern, multi-cultural flair.

SOUTHERN ENGLAND

A widely recognised centre for fashion, gastronomy, art and theatre, London's distinction lies in its ability to combine this dynamic, multi-cultural vibrancy with tradition and a monarchical history going back centuries. Venturing outside of London to the serenity of the English countryside, Warwick and Stratford-upon-Avon are internationally recognised, while the Cotswold Hills are a vision of rural life. Rolling hills, thatched cottages and a liberal sprinkling of colourful wild flowers lead you through the picturesque villages of Bibury, Chipping Campden and Broadway. England's southwest peninsula is flanked by a dramatic and beautiful coastline scattered with tiny fishing villages and beautiful coves nestled between the cliffs.

NORTHERN ENGLAND

Conjuring images of a romantic wilderness, northern England is home to magnificent national parks. The Lake District sees the pretty villages of Grasmere and Keswick perched on the shores of glittering lakes while further east, the Yorkshire Dales and rolling moors of the Peak District are adorned with numerous stately homes including Castle Howard, Chatsworth House and Belvoir Castle.

WALES

A drive west through North Wales reveals the dramatic rugged mountains and wild landscapes of Snowdonia National Park. Step back in time as the notable turrets of Caernarfon and Conwy castles evoke stories of past conflicts. Further south, St David's Cathedral and Tintern Abbey offer poetic retreats, or, for something more lively, join the passionate Welsh and watch the national game of rugby at the impressive Millennium Stadium.

SCOTLAND

A land of legend, romance and majestic scenery,
Scotland's kilts, bagpipes, castles and clans have
sparked the imaginations of many. The capital city of
Edinburgh is a World Heritage Site and, meandering
through the winding medieval streets, flanked by
beautiful Georgian and Regency architecture, it's
easy to see why. Edinburgh Castle dominates the
city, perched on an ancient volcanic mound
watching over the bustle below while the charming
Royal Mile leads from here down to the elegant
Palace of Holyrood House, one of the many royal

associations to be found in Scotland. A welcoming and vibrant city, Edinburgh plays host to numerous festivals such as the Military Tattoo and Hogmanay.

Beyond the city, rural Scotland is a captivating realm of craggy mountains, idyllic glens and serene lochs. Magical landmarks such as Inveraray Castle, eerie Glencoe and imposing Ben Nevis will punctuate your journey towards the striking Atlantic Coast where towering mountains sweep down towards the sea and the unspoiled Hebridean Islands of Skye and Iona.

IRELAND

Renowned for its hospitality, 'the Emerald Isle' is one of striking natural beauty, wonderful architecture, a lively culture of music and dance and a rich literary history. The welcoming capital of Dublin is home to stylish designer boutiques, fine monuments and a host of traditional Irish pubs. The country's spectacular coastal scenery is nicely complemented by a number of picturesque coastal towns such as Galway, famous for its fresh oysters and a gateway to the wild beauty of Connemara.

Nearby, the Aran Islands uphold Irish tradition by maintaining Gaelic as a language.

Northern Ireland's capital city of Belfast has emerged from its troubled past to become a vibrant, friendly destination. Must-sees include the World Heritage Site of Giant's Causeway, an unusual collection of basalt columns forming stepping stones that lead into the sea.

ITALY & CROATIA

With an appreciation of food, history and beauty deep-rooted in the national identity of many Italians, Italy is a wonderfully diverse destination that never disappoints at any time of year.

Additionally, beautiful coastlines and historic towns in Croatia, Slovenia and Montenegro continue to attract visitors to the Adriatic coast.

NORTHERNITALY

Built entirely on water, the extraordinary floating city of Venice oozes romantic charm. A labyrinth of intriguing streets, connected by intricate bridges, showcase a stunning mix of Byzantine, Gothic and Renaissance architecture.

Liguria, or 'The Italian Riviera', encompasses the glamorous Portofino and the quaint and colourful villages of the Cinque Terre, famous for the picturesque hiking paths that run between them.

The dynamic city of Milan serves as Italy's capital of fashion and design and is also home to da Vinci's 'Last Supper'. In contrast, the Italian Lake District offers the visitor a haven of palatial villas, rose-laden belvederes, hanging wisteria and majestic Alpine vistas.

CENTRALITALY

Shaped through 2,700 years of history, Rome is a cornucopia of artistic and architectural masterpieces and classical ruins sitting alongside the impressive papal state of the Vatican City.

Umbria is an ancient region blessed with peaceful, undulating countryside and fast-flowing rivers.

The architecturally rich towns of Perugia, Assisi and Orvieto are well worth exploring.

Rural Tuscany, with its beautiful landscape and rustic hidden gems is a delight to visit, while the region's towns boast much in the way of art, local artisans and exquisite food and wine. Florence, in particular, remains a monument to the Renaissance. Festivals and pageants, such as the Palio in Siena, are held with ancient pomp and ceremony whilst towns such as San Gimignano and Lucca hold an abundance of archaic charm.



SOUTHERN ITALY

The Amalfi Coast takes travellers past rocky cliffs plunging into the sea. Amalfi, Ravello and Positano cling precariously to steep cliff sides whilst the islands of sophisticated Capri and its peaceful neighbour, Ischia, beckon. A short drive away, Pompeii and Herculaneum reveal towns frozen in time since their burial in AD79 under the molten lava of Vesuvius.

The island of Sicily possesses an old world charm whilst vast historical influences from across the Mediterranean are evident in the temples of Agrigento and Syracuse and the Greek Theatre at Taormina.

Puglia is less well known but similarly charming, occupying the quiet 'heel' of Italy and resembling Greece with its whitewashed houses and stunning beaches.

CROATIA

Croatia's capital Zagreb is a cosmopolitan city awash with cultural institutions, theatres, galleries, cafes and markets alongside a host of historical treasures.

Istria is a natural paradise with three national parks and a beautiful coastline providing a stunning backdrop to the historic towns of Porec and Rovinj, both of which display a strong Venetian influence whilst Pula is known for its Roman monuments.

The Dalmatian coast is a picture of turquoise blue waters and striking orange roofs. Split's Roman town is full of charm whilst the UNESCO city of Dubrovnik is home to celebrated sights such as the

14th century Sponza Palace and the Dominican Monastery. The idyllic Dalmatian Islands lie just a short boat ride from the coast and are a paradise of beautiful beaches, colourful wild flowers and authentic wines.

MONTENEGRO

The striking UNESCO city of Kotor lies within a spectacular fjord and reflects a remarkable legacy of Roman culture. The town of Budva is also a treasure house of cultural heritage, perched upon a small peninsula. For those looking for a relaxing retreat, the exclusive resort of Sveti Stefan offers beautiful and secluded sandy beaches.

SLOVENIA

The small country of Slovenia is one of Europe's lesser-known gems. The relaxed and friendly capital of Ljubljana is characterised by its beautiful baroque architecture and younger art-nouveau designs. Further north, the stunning Lake Bled is an enchanting picture postcard with the Assumption of Mary Pilgrimage Church famously positioned on a small island in the pristine glacial lake.

RUSSIA



Covering such a vast area, Russia is a fascinating meld of Oriental, European and Asian traditions.

Still widely undiscovered, Russia is one of the great destinations for travel in the 21st century.

MOSCOW

The legacy of the Imperial and Soviet years still remains strongly evident in Moscow but the city now sits alongside modern, western influences to create a contemporary and evolving capital. The Kremlin on Red Square recounts the core of Russian history, housing treasures gathered by both Tsars and Empresses. Next to the Kremlin, Red Square is also home to St Basil's Cathedral and Lenin's Mausoleum. Moscow is also a centre of the arts with an abundance of galleries and the legendary Bolshoi Theatre where Tchaikovsky's Swan Lake premiered.

ST PETERSBURG

A city of timeless glamour and elegant architecture, St Petersburg has recovered its former glory since the devastating siege during WWII and has emerged with a deep historic feel and spirit of reform. One of the world's greatest art galleries, the Hermitage, reflects the authority of former imperial Russia, whilst the golden dome of St Isaac's Cathedral dominates the skyline. St Petersburg also boasts many vast palaces, the most famous of which is in Pushkin where Catherine I commissioned her grand Summer Palace in 1717. The flamboyant Rococo style and lavish interior were added over the years by subsequent empresses.



THE GOLDEN RING

Dotted with churches and onion-shaped domes, the circle of towns to the northeast of Moscow forms an excellent touring itinerary outside of the city into rural Russia. Dating back to the 11th century, the towns of Vladimir, Suzdal, Yaroslavl and Rostov were flourishing trade centres while Sergiev Posad was known as a religious centre following the foundation of the Trinity Monastery of St Sergius.

KAMCHATKA

Home to magnificently diverse and abundant wildlife, Kamchatka is an untouched land of majestic volcanoes, steaming geysers, wild bears and pacific salmon making it a UNESCO site unlike any other.

VOLGA RIVER CRUISE

An ideal way to experience authentic Russia, a Volga river cruise leads you out of the cities into a rural and simpler realm still abundant with elaborate wooden houses and a deep-rooted way of life. Sail through the largest lakes in Europe and authentic Russia beyond the lights of the Kremlin.

UZBEKISTAN, KAZAKHSTAN, TURKMENISTAN & AZERBAIJAN

FRANCE

the Hofbrauhaus, Munich's most famous beer hall, and the enchanting medieval villages and romantic countryside of the Black Forest.

GRFFCF

The Ancient Greeks were at the forefront of creative thinking, writing and theatre, the results of which still underpin much of our modern world today. Greece's rugged landscape is awash with the evidence of this ancient world from the imposing Acropolis which dominates the skyline of Athens, to Ancient Olympia, home to the original Olympic Games. Meanwhile, for those looking to relax against an idyllic backdrop, the Greek islands conjure up images of pristine beaches, crystal waters and winding paths flanked with iconic whitewashed houses.

BELGIUM, THE NETHERLANDS & LUXEMBOURG

Though some of the smallest countries in Europe, Belgium, the Netherlands and Luxembourg are rich in history and offer a host of great artists. Belgium's capital Brussels is home to one of the most ornate market squares in Europe, while the picture postcard towns of Ghent and Bruges are gems of medieval architecture. Meanwhile, Amsterdam's canals and gabled houses set this cosmopolitan city quite apart from others in Europe. Spring in the Netherlands also brings with it a myriad of colour as tulips, crocuses and hyacinths burst into bloom making gardens such as Keukenhof and Lisse well worth a visit.

HUNGARY, AUSTRIA & CZECH REPUBLIC

Ideally combined into a tour of central Europe's most enchanting cities, Budapest, Vienna and Prague suggest an element of the old-world with their cobbled streets and traditional coffee houses. Prague's unique gothic architecture nicely complements the romantic imperial palaces of Vienna and Salzburg while the vibrant spa city of Budapest offers majestic baroque, neoclassical and art-nouveau architecture in abundance.

POLAND & SLOVAKIA

Few countries have survived such a turbulent past as that of Poland, yet this beautiful country lives to recount its fascinating history through its churches and palaces. Warsaw was largely destroyed during the war but painstaking reconstruction has restored many of the city's great landmarks. To the south, Krakow, full of impressive medieval architecture, is one of the oldest cities in Europe and is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Conversely, Slovenia's capital, Bratislava, is one of the youngest capitals in Europe yet boasts a wonderful old town and a striking castle from which you can gain spectacular views of the city.
